What can community visitors do?

Community Visitors volunteer their time regularly and develop a relationship with the resident to support them in participating in activities such as:

- chatting together and reminiscing
- playing cards or other games
- listening to music
- taking a walk
- having a coffee

The activities you do together will be depend on what the resident would like.

Sometimes these activities can include 2 or 3 residents as a group activity.
